Attention: PIB Members & Taxpayers,  
The tax department will be mailing out a notice pursuant to section 6 of the First Nations Fiscal Management Act (FMA) to everyone. By FMA Law, we have to give notice regarding the PIB Property Taxation Law and the PIB Assessment law 2015. This is simply a transition of Tax regime from our current Section 83 to FMA. This mail-out will happen by the end of next week.
