### Technician Level I (On-Call)

The Technician Level 1 provides field and office support for all projects associated with PIB Natural Resources including: data collection and processing, environmental and cultural research, in-field cultural and environmental investigations, monitoring and tracking, and the conduct of any and all technical and Traditional Ecological Knowledge (TEK) studies associated with PIB Natural Resources.

### Duties / Responsibilities

- Assisting the PIB Senior Technicians, Biologists and Referrals staff with in-field works associated with Natural Resources (environmental monitoring, RISC monitoring, Archaeological surveys (i.e. CMT surveys) and risk assessments, land restoration, fish and wildlife projects).
- Planting and monitoring of vegetation.
- Water assessment and monitoring.
- Wildlife and fisheries assessments and monitoring.
- Cultural assessments and monitoring.
- Carrying equipment to and from sites and assisting with set up.
- Maintaining and organizing a job-related log book for data reporting purposes (e.g. temperatures etc.).
- Recording and input of detailed field notes for data reporting purposes.
- Other duties as required of this position.

### Minimum Academic/Educational Requirements

- Successful completion Grade 10
- 18 years of age.

- Ability to adhere to and observe worksite specific safety regulations at all times.
- Work experience in Cultural, Archaeological, Wildlife or Fisheries related field work.
- Ability to work flexible work schedules.

### Working Conditions

The work is performed in an office or field environment often in difficult weather and terrain conditions. Employees may be exposed to animals, insects, inclement weather, travel by small boat, contact with chemicals, etc.. The work continually requires attention and concentration. Participation in projects such as research surveys and in-field activities may involve periods of greater physical effort. The conduct of field activities involves occasional exposure to risk of lost time injury from sprains or fractures or illness from chemical exposure. During archaeology in-field activities employees may be exposed to ancestral remains.
