## **REMINDER NOTICE TO LEASE HOLDERS – DURING COVID-19 EPIDEMIC/PANDEMIC**

Please be advised that the Penticton Indian Band has a fiduciary obligation to ensure the health and well-being of the community and its members. We are committed to ensuring that the coronavirus is contained and is doing everything possible to prevent the spread of the disease, COVID-19.

We can slow the spread of COVID-19 by making a conscious effort to keep a physical distance between each other. Physical (social) distancing is proven to be one of the most effective ways to reduce the spread of illness during an outbreak. Two arm lengths is the recommended distance.

Washing your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds is also recommended particularly after using the washroom, when servicing customers and when preparing food.

The coronavirus is one of the easiest types of viruses to kill with the proper disinfectants products. Even a simple bleach solution of 1 teaspoon (5ml) per cup (250 ml) would suffice to clean hard surfaces, such as:

Tools	Door handles
Toilets	Remotes
Phones	ATM keypads
Electronics	Countertops

COVID-19 is a very serious health risk. It is particularly severe for populations of those over the age of 65 years, those with compromised immune systems and those with underlying medical conditions.

We must all do our part in ensuring that we do our utmost to prevent the spread of the coronavirus by practicing “social distancing”, and ensuring proper hygiene.
