**NOTICE TO COMMUNITY MEMBERS**

An Evacuation Alert has been expanded by the Penticton Indian Band for the Marron Valley area due to the threat of the KEREMEOS CREEK WILDFIRE and because of the potential danger to life, health and property damage. Civic addresses or lot number(s) of the affected properties are below:

This Evacuation Alert has been issued as a precaution to variable conditions. Please take this time to prepare to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary.

Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

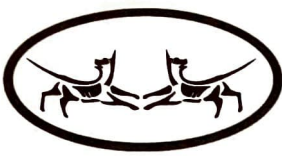

***WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN ALERT IS IN EFFECT***

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated
- Pack essential items such as: government-issued ID; medications; eyeglasses; valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit and mortgage information); immediate care needs for dependents; and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed (if you identify as having extraordinary needs contact PIB EOC for assistance).
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible) – pet owners and hobby farmers with concern for their animals can contact Animal Emergency Response Team (ALERT) at 250-809-7152 or [info@alertcanada.org](mailto:info@alertcanada.org). Farmers should contact the PIB EOC.
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles. If transportation assistance is needed, call the PIB EOC.
- Store your firearms in accordance with Section 118 of the Fire Arms Act.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of your residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor news sources.
- Pre-register at [ess.gov.bc.ca](http://ess.gov.bc.ca) – NOTE: you will need to either attend a reception centre or call (insert contact names and numbers) if the ALERT is expanded to an ORDER.

**WHEREAS:** the Chief and Council of the Pentiction Indian Band are empowered to act on behalf of the Pentiction Indian Band (PIB), and where Chief and Council has authorized one person to sign States of Local Emergency and Evacuation Alerts and Orders in the event of an Emergency.

**WHEREAS:** PIB Chief and Council are responsible for the health and safety of its Community Members;

**WHEREAS:** The Pentiction Indian Band (PIB) Emergency Operations Center (PIB EOC) has been activated in response to the Keremeos Creek Fire;

**WHEREAS:** The PIB EOC has been actively engaged with BC Wildfire Service from the beginning of the Keremeos Creek Fire and will continue to be engaged for the duration of the fire;

**WHEREAS:** The BC Wildfire has recommended an extension of an Evacuation Alert in the area of Marron Valley;

**WHEREAS:** The PIB EOC, in regular communications with BC Wildfire has recommended an Evacuation Alert to be issued to the properties and homes in the affected area.

**WHEREAS:** The PIB EOC has included a map of the area;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:**

That the Chief and Council of the Pentiction Indian Band have issued an Evacuation Alert, as a precaution, for areas of IR No.1 for:
