

Did you know that a dripping faucet can waste up to 20 gallons of water a day?

Dear Community Members,

The Penticton Indian Band Utilities Department is requesting your support in conserving water for both the Upper and Lower water systems during planned valve maintenance. The maintenance will take place from

March 19th to March 21st, 2025, during working hours (9:00 AM to 4:00 PM).

The valve maintenance requires specific safety measures, such as bypassing the valve or complete isolation of utilities buildings. This process may cause intermittent disruptions to the water supply but is crucial to ensuring the safety of workers from high water pressures during the maintenance.

To ensure that both the Upper and Lower water systems function effectively during this time, it is essential to reduce water consumption. We kindly ask for your cooperation in using water sparingly throughout the maintenance period. We appreciate your understanding and support in this important matter.

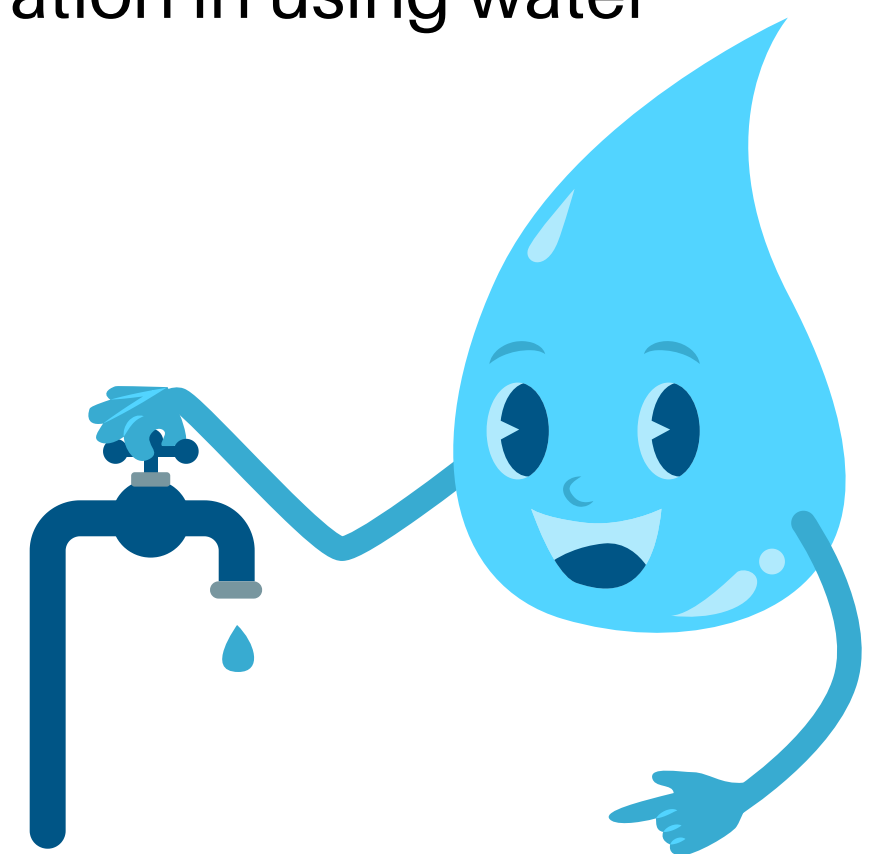
