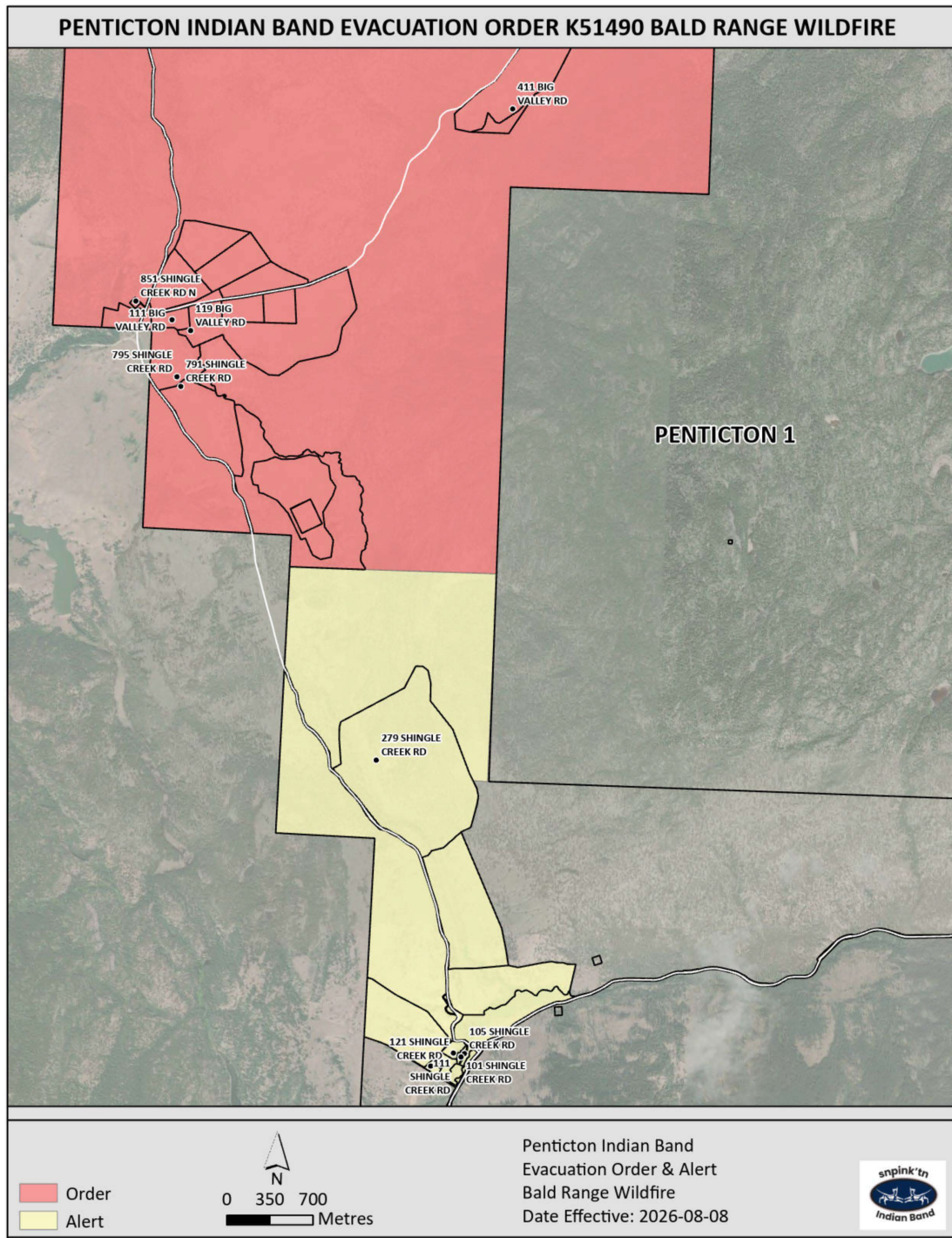

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area **IMMEDIATELY**
- Follow the directions of emergency responders and travel the designated or safest route available
- If you need transportation assistance from the evacuation area, contact PIB Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) – call **EOC Liaison – Lesley Gabriel (250) 809-1895**
- If you identify as having extraordinary needs, contact the EOC for assistance.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances (**DO NOT SHUT OFF REFRIGERATORS OR FREEZERS**)
- Close all windows and doors
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather your family and if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you need to help reduce traffic congestion.
- Take critical items only if they are immediately available, such as: government-issued ID; medications; eyeglasses; valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit and mortgage information); immediate care needs for dependents)
- Take pets in pet kennels or on a leash: pet owners and hobby farmers with concern for their animals can contact Animal Emergency Response Team (ALERT) at 250-809-7152 or info@alertcanada.org. Farmers should contact the PIB EOC.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service or assistance.

This evacuation order will remain in effect until rescinded by snpink'tn Indian Band.
