RESCINDING OF STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY (SOLE)

August 28, 2026

Whereas the snpink'tn Indian Band (Penticton Indian Band) declared a State of Local Emergency on August 8, 2026, due to the imminent threat posed by the Bald Range Fire K51490 to Penticton Indian Reserve No. 1 (IR1), including the Shingle Creek area, Penticton Indian Reserve No. 3 (IR3), and community members;

And whereas the State of Local Emergency authorized the snpink'tn Indian Band Chief and Council, employees, contractors, and agents to work with the primary response agency and take the actions necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of community members;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Effective 2:00pm on August 28, 2026, the State of Local Emergency (SOLE) declared by the snpink'tn Indian Band on August 8, 2026, in relation to the Bald Range Fire K51490 is hereby rescinded.

Effective the date and time noted above, the State of Local Emergency has ended and all emergency powers granted under it are no longer in effect.

The snpink'tn Indian Band will continue to monitor conditions and work with emergency response agencies as required to support community safety and recovery efforts.
